For a minute I thought it was my wife's Tesla that forced the lorry onto the verge! But on closer inspection it is the wrong number plate; Phew !

There is not much that can be done by Highways.

On School Lane, after the verge was torn up hundreds of times opposite the school because of the the Highways department but "GrassCrete" into the verge which can withstand pressure from tyres, but it hasn't worked that well.

Posts in the verge get knocked down and don't look great in my opinion, especially as they get old. In the past it has been discussed making Back Lane/Front St one way so there is a circulation around the village, but Highways was not keen on that idea.

We could ask the Parish Council to put up some temporary small signs saying "Please do not drive on our verges" to see if that works.
