Morning Donna,

I spoke with Jodi yesterday as we discussed. I have explained to her I am in the process of changing my shifts alongside PC Ben Trowman due to us now covering the new area. We also now have a PCSO, PCSO Luke Harris who has come from Evesham town centre. One of Lukes tasking is Meon Way Gardens re the reports of ASB. I have explained to Jodi that the videos she sends in are not criminal offences, such as boys riding their bikes in the middle of the road and knock and run etc. The only way we can intervene here really is if we are there to see it ourselves, which as you know is difficult. However saying that, I have asked Luke to be there when we can and in the evenings. The boys in these videos have been spoken too either by myself or housing and there are things going on with the families which I can not disclose. Jodi did mention about the meeting in December and the play area will be discussed which she thinks will attract a lot of residents due to potential ASB it may cause. I have said if I can attend, or Luke we will, but also, I hold drop in sessions in Meon Way Gardens more than any other area, and this is a great way for people to come and see me to discuss ASB if they have concerns, however, very very few people show up, and the ones that do, are the same people each time, such as Eugene, which is great as he gives me a very good overview of the concerns from the residents, but if there was a problem I would be expect to see some more people. I have just ran a report for the last 90 days to see what ASB reports we have had in for Meon Way Gardens and there is zero! I have as you will be aware had videos sent in from Jodi re boys cycling in the middle of the road and rubbish related to one of the properties on Bennets Rise, which was passed on to housing and dealt with.

Hope that eases some peoples minds with regards what is happening on Meon Way. We obviously do attend Meon Way Gardens for other reports such as assaults, DV etc, but this happens everywhere as we talked about.
