## Planting Plan Detail & Strategy

Pebworth in Bloom has worked hard to improve not only the aesthetic value of the village but also increase biodiversity. The pond and planted areas of the village are a great example of this.

Based on my visit I can suggest the following (see above plan):

### **Additional tree planting**

Additional trees to the hedgerows can help to increase biodiversity as many species will use the trees and the hedge for movement in the landscape (birds/butterfly species).

See below for tree species suggestions but small to medium species 20m max recommended along hedge rows.

### **Hedgerows**

Potential for planting a native hedgerow around the allotments which will help to increase pollinators and aid with pest control of crops.

Less intensive management of hedgerows recommended. A project that you want to take on as part of developing your Local Nature Action Plan is surveying hedgerows and improving their management:

<b>Woodland Trust packs Wild Harvest/Year-round colour:</b> hazel, blackthorn, crab apple, elder, dog rose, rowan, hawthorn, dogwood, wild cherry, silver birch	Dependent on length recommend 5-6 trees per 1m for a double hedgerow.	Can use for gapping/underplanting of hedges. Hedging
