Good Morning Donna

I wonder if I could kindly ask you to forward a request from Marston Sicca PC to your members.

Residents of Meon Vale have been asking Marston Sicca PC to install a bus shelter on the site for some time. The main bus stop on Bailey Avenue is quite exposed, which results in residents waiting under the shelter of Londis (on the opposite side of the road) until the bus arrives. We spoke with WCC, St Modwen and two key suppliers to organise the process and secure best price. All parties were agreed that this would be a sensible spend, and the work will be concluded this week. It is not, however, inexpensive, and whilst benefitting all residents of Meon Vale using public transport, is a cost obligation of Marston Sicca.

Our PC members wondered if Pebworth PC would consider contributing £1000 towards the cost (I have attached the figures for your perusal). As you are aware, Meon falls within three parishes, so I am also asking same of Quinton PC. We have prepared for the noted costs but as there will be ongoing maintenance, a contribution at this time would be much appreciated.
